The benefits to your business;

Commitment to social good, by supporting local services to join the foyer movement your business will have a direct & tangible impact on young people experiencing homelessness in your local community.

Employee Engagement We are looking for corporate partners who would be interested in forging relationships with Foyers in their local areas and in offering placements, shadow days, on-the-job training and mentoring to young people.

Support a diverse group The young people living in Foyers come to us during a period of homelessness. They're aged between 16 and 25, and come from a range of different communities, cultures and socio-economic backgrounds. by investing in their future your business is showing a commitment to ED&I.

HOW CAN WE WORK TOGETHER?

It costs £8,500 per foyer to deliver our full foyer offer to our members.

We ask our members to commit to providing a full foyer offer as well as a financial contribution of £1,500 in membership fees, we then work with partners to fundraise the remaining £7,000.

With your support we could expand the Foyer Network which would:

- Give young people access to our vital support including, move on grants, Talent Bonds Programme, youth power programmes and a voice within the sector.
- Allow Staff to access essential training and development in areas such as mental health, trauma informed practices, restorative practices and

Strategic Partners- A contribution of £5000 would support a new Foyer to join the network, on average that is X YP and X Staff members accessing our support

Foundational Partners- A contribution of £10,000 would support 2 new Foyers to join the network
